Setebos Malbec is a refined expression of high-altitude viticulture from Altamira, one of the most prestigious sub-regions of the Uco Valley. Grown at the foothills of the Andes, this wine reflects purity, balance, and freshness, shaped by cool nights and mineral-rich soils.

VINTAGE: 2025

GRAPE VARIETIES:

95 % Malbec

5% Cabernet Franc

VINIFICATION: Fermented in concrete tanks, with a small percentage of whole-bunch Cabernet Franc to enhance structure and aromatic complexity.

TASTING NOTES

Appearance: Deep ruby red with violet hues, clean and bright.

Nose: Dark berries, blackcurrant, and blueberry, layered with subtle notes of vanilla and spice.

Palate: Smooth tannins, medium- to full-bodied, with vibrant natural acidity that delivers freshness and balance, driven by Altamira's cool climate conditions."

ORIGIN & TERROIR:

Altamira, Uco Valley, Mendoza — located at the foothills of the Andes, renowned for its elegance, minerality, and precision.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Cork: Natural micro-agglomerated cork

Bottle: Premium thick glass bottle (560 g)

Alcohol: 13.9% alc. by vol.

FOOD PAIRING: Grilled meats, lamb, roasted vegetables, and aged cheeses.
